GENERAL JOB DESCRIPTION

Responsible for installation of electrical components on newly manufactured MASABA mining equipment located at manufacturing site; responsible for troubleshooting, identifying the root cause, repairing or replacing parts, rewiring, and installing related electrical components on MASABA mining equipment at off-site locations; will perform industrial wiring to include maintenance and service for MASABA mining equipment at off-site locations; ensure all work performed is done by following all local and national electrical codes.

ESSENTIAL JOB REQUIREMENTS

- Must have previous educational training and/or certification in electronics and electrical theory.
- Extensive working experience in electronics, electrical wiring and electrical troubleshooting.
- Must possess or working towards a valid electrician's license
- Demonstrate strong safety leadership skills and follow safe work practices.
- Work as part of a team to plan and conduct equipment repairs.
- Respond to unplanned/emergency work requests in a timely & effective manner
- Be highly motivated and able to work independently.
